The Board of Directors hires and gives advice and consent to the Executive Director. We are a non-profit corporation operating under the laws of the State of Oregon. Board Members serve for a two-year term and are elected just before our annual meeting in November. If someone wishes to serve, they can contact the office and we will make arrangements for you to attend a couple of board meetings. If you attend two consecutive board meetings and decide you would like to serve, the sitting board votes on your admission to the Board. You will then

be placed on the ballot for the next election, so you may join the Board at anytime. You need to be a member of the Society and be willing to take on assignments given by the Executive Board or the Executive Secretary.
